→ Wellness immunizations include those used to protect against measles, mumps, rubella, polio, tetanus, whooping cough, and chickenpox.



IDAHO LAW SUPPORTS PARENTAL CHOICE



Idaho preschool/K-12 public and private schools require children to meet minimum immunization documentation prerequisites for attendance.

The State of Idaho currently allows parents to choose. They can either:

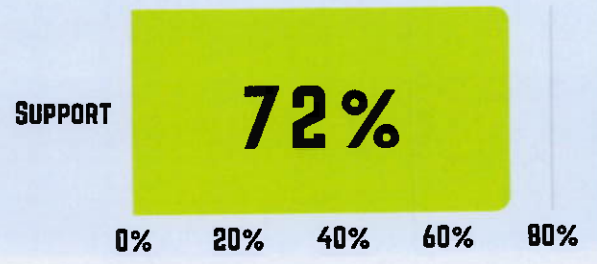
- provide documentation of their children's wellness immunizations;
- **OR** have their child exempted from providing documentation for any personal, medical, religious, or philosophical reason.

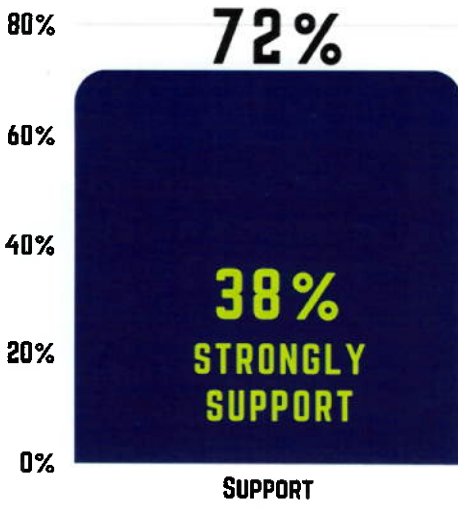
»» Exemption is simple. ««

Parents can fill out a form or provide a written statement to the school stating they have an objection to the immunization requirement.

IDAHOANS SUPPORT THE CURRENT OPT-OUT SYSTEM

The **State of Idaho's current opt-out system** for children's wellness immunization documentation **has broad support**, even among the most conservative Republicans.

Idahoans like **having the choice** to either provide documentation of their children's wellness immunizations **or** exempt them.

PARENTS IN IDAHO HAVE THE CHOICE ABOUT WHETHER THEIR CHILDREN GET VACCINATED OR NOT.

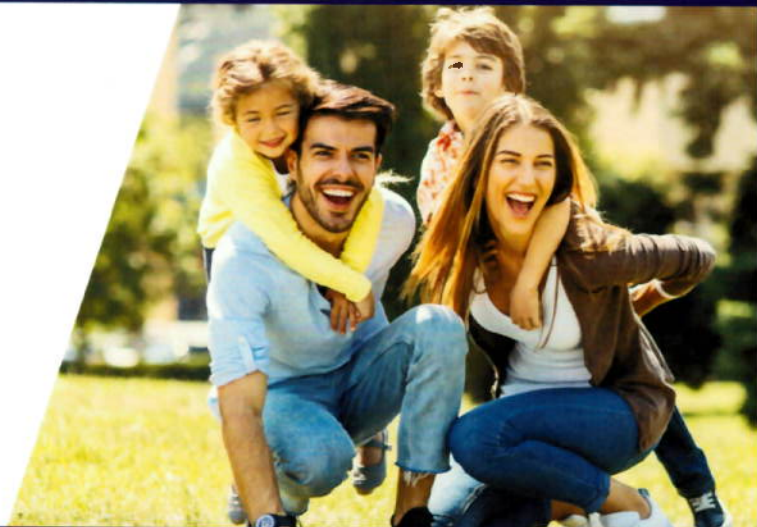
- Nothing and no one can force anyone to get an immunization.
